

Dr. Bogner is an Associate Professor of Pharmaceutics at the University of Connecticut in its School of Pharmacy. She received her Ph.D. in Pharmaceutics from Rutgers University in 1990. Her fields of research include physical and chemical stabilization of poorly water-soluble drugs in the amorphous state; determination of the effects of grinding and co-grinding on the properties of drugs; interactions of drug molecules with silicate surfaces; rapid in vitro screening methods to predict enhanced bioavailability of a series of forms of a drug; mathematical modeling of pH across *S. mutans* biofilms; and calcium supplement absorption as a function of duodenal bicarbonate secretion.
